We support international people in the city by offering regular events, such as the Connect Welcome Month. Here, too, we work with our partners to offer their expertise to people that require it.


Events and networking

Partnership expectations


- Inform The Hague International Centre of updates to your product portfolio and relevant company information (name change/new logo/contact details), so this can be shared with our audience in timely fashion.

Partnership criteria

All participating partners must meet the following criteria.

The organisation must:

- Offer its services in one of the following sectors: business networks, childcare, education, employment, finance, healthcare, housing, international clubs and networks, language, legal, media or tax.
- Offer its services or products in The Hague region.
- Offer relevant information in English and/or another relevant language for internationals (offline and online, customer service, complaints procedure, forms, etc.)
- Demonstrate a minimum of two years' experience in the international market.
- Provide a minimum of two references by international customers/companies.
- Agree to the cooperation (terms of the contract) and to participate in a customer satisfaction survey.
- Meet the requirements of the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR).
- Agree to the sharing, linking, and promoting of related articles and logo of The Hague International Centre on its website, newsletter or social media.
